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Errata

In Piya Pal-Lapinski's article, "Infection as Resistance: Medical Discourse, Indian Courtesans, and Flawed Memsahibs in Flora Steel's Colonial Fiction" (Volume 30, Number 3, July 1999), the title of James Johnson's 1813 book should be corrected to read, *The Influence of Tropical Climates, More Especially the Climate of India, on European Institutions* (p. 142).

In Elisabetta Tarantino's article "The House That Jack Did Not Build: Textual Strategies in V. S. Naipaul's *The Enigma of Arrival*" (Volume 29, Number 4, October 1998) imperfect copyediting regrettably generated an inadvertent but substantial modification of the author's meaning (and a typographical error) on page 176, lines 10-11: "Ironically, it is thought the universalizing (anti-dogmatic, anti-essentialist) stance of this novel . . ." should read: "It may seem ironic, but it is in fact due to the universalizing (anti-dogmatic, anti-essentialist) stance of this novel . . ."
