
Canadian Revue of Comparative Literature/Revue Canadienne de Littérature Comparée

The journal is published quarterly by University of Toronto Press for the Canadian Comparative Literature Association, and provides a forum for scholars engaged in the study of literature from both an international and an indisciplinary point of view. It publishes articles on the international history of literature, theory of literature, methods of literary scholarship, and the selection of literature with other spheres of human expression. The review encourages papers on the present state of research in certain areas of comparative literature, review articles and studies on comparative Canadian literature; it publishes a yearly bibliography of comparative Canadian literature and a 96 page "Revues des revues" covering 300 articles from some 90 major periodicals. Editorial matters and subscription inquiries by members of the CCLA and ACLA should be directed to the editor (M. V. Dimié, Department of Comparative Literature, University of Alberta, Edmonton, Alberta T6G 2E6). The 1980 price schedule is: Single copies \$5.00; one-year individual subscriptions \$12.00 and institutional subscriptions \$16.00. Members of the CCLA receive the review as part of their membership; annual dues are \$18.00 for regular members and \$9.00 for students; life memberships are \$200.00.



WLWE is a journal devoted to criticism and discussion of Commonwealth literature, Third World writing in English and New World literature in English. Contributions of a scholarly critical nature are welcome on these and related subjects; contributions are also solicited specifically for a special issue on Canada in the Commonwealth. Other special features in future issues will include a section on Doris Lessing (1981) and one on English writing in Singapore and Malaysia (1982).
