Articles in the academic areas of educational psychology, curriculum, instructional methodology, educational administration, educational communications, intercultural education, comparative education, religious education, and others are all welcomed considerations for publication in JET.

In short, if an article is qualitative, scholarly, and deals with any aspect of the most general notion of educational thought, we would like to review your article. Too often has the editor heard from authors telling of articles they believed to be superb yet felt their content would be unsuitable for JET, since JET dealt mainly with philosophy of education issues. JET has dealt with and will deal with these issues in the future, but not only with philosophy of education issues. Articles of an educational foundations nature still suit JET. However, JET wears other suits as well, but it has seldom had occasion to wear them. If you have an article that your think is meritorious, please send it to us.

In hopes of satisfying our readership and our authors as well as maintaining the international standards JET has established, we wish to diversify JET through the publication of articles in a variety of areas related and useful to education. We rely on your support through your submission of quality articles in any of the diverse yet integrated areas we mentioned.
